

Length of Stay in Secure Detention, 2002*

Length of stay is reported as the median, in place of the mean or average, for better accuracy in reporting. The average can be affected by one extreme case remaining in detention for a long period, while the median would not be affected in this manner. The median is defined as the value above and below which half the cases fall. In 2002, the median length of stay in secure detention is 10 days, which is consistent with the last three reporting years.

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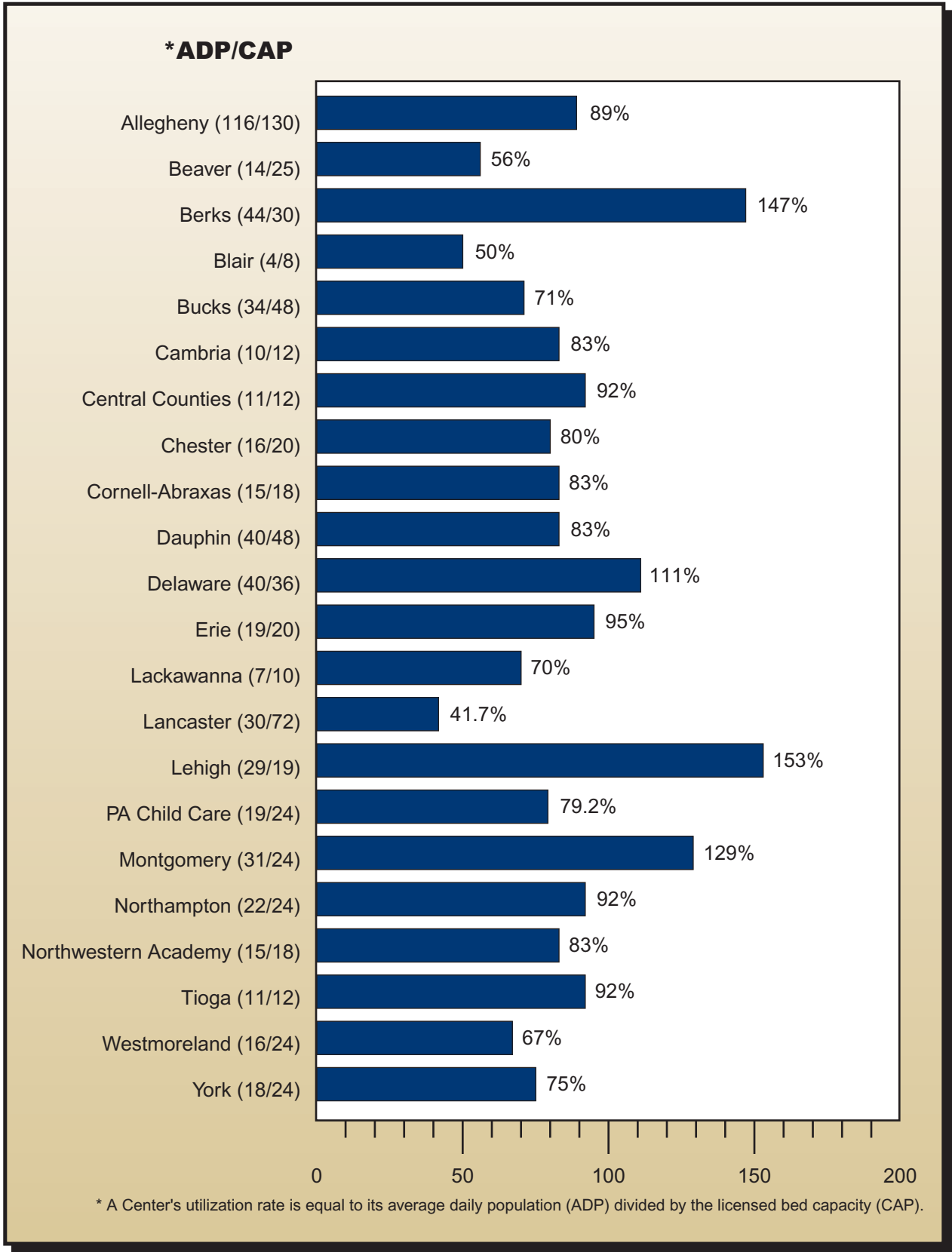

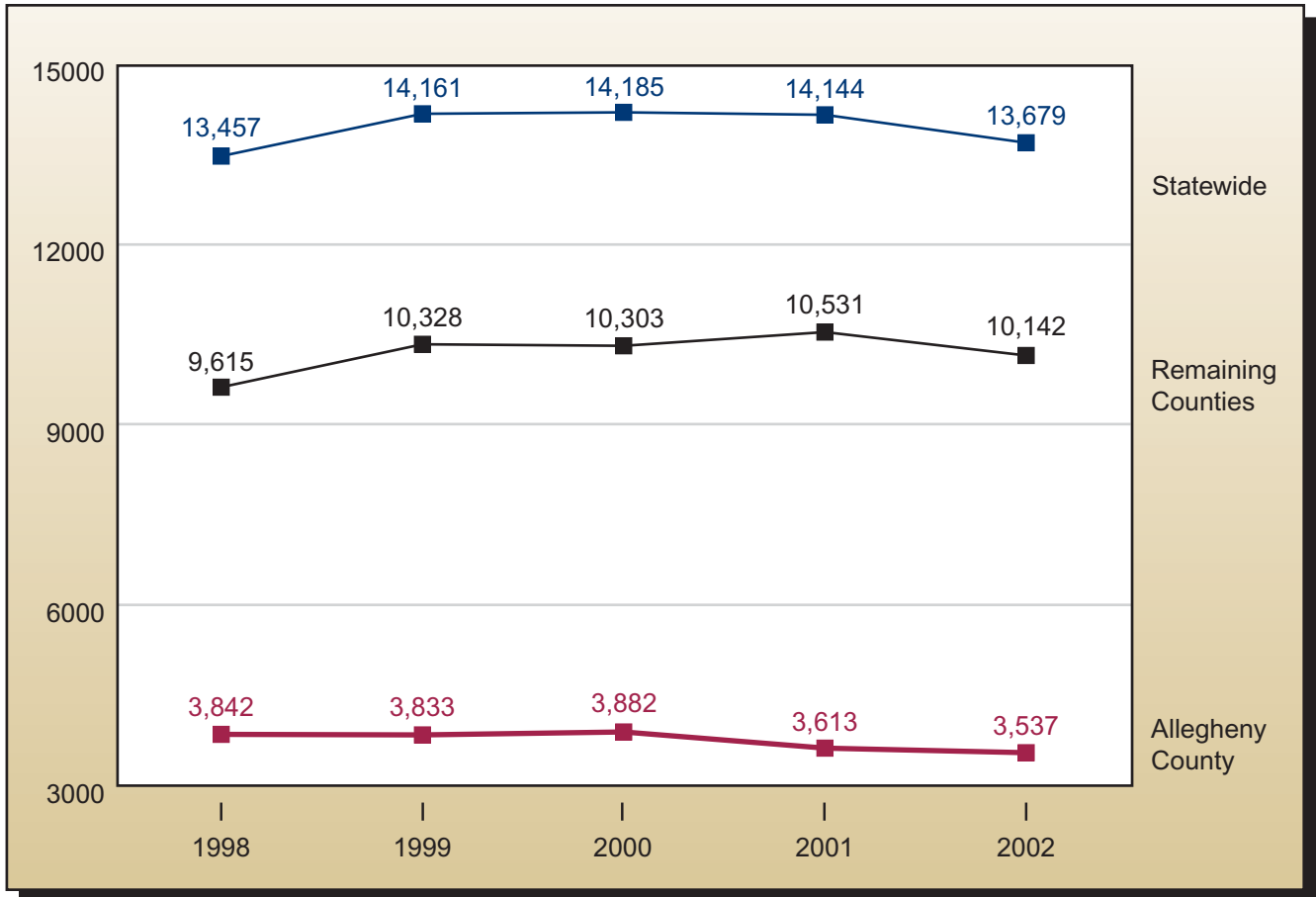
Utilization Rates for Pennsylvania Juvenile Detention Centers, 2002

In 2002, new admissions to secure detention totaled 13,679, which is a 3.3 percent decrease under the number of statewide detention center admissions in 2001.

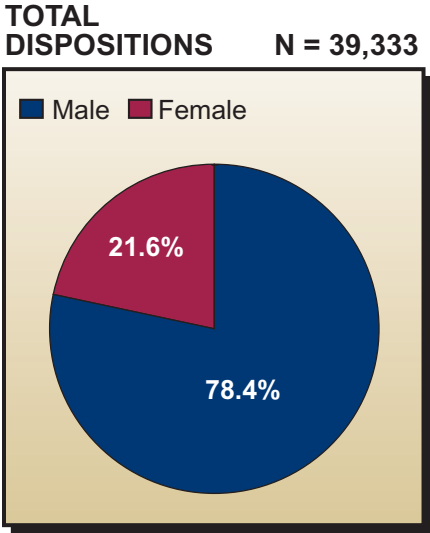
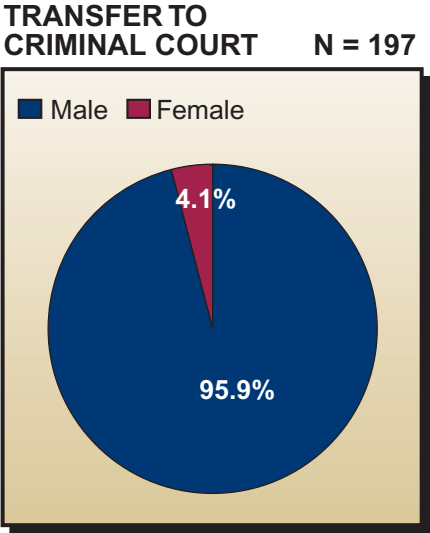
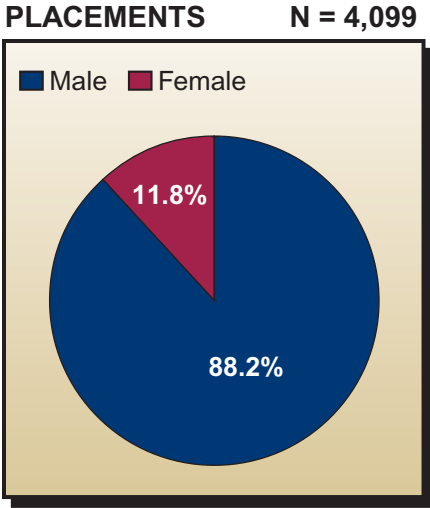
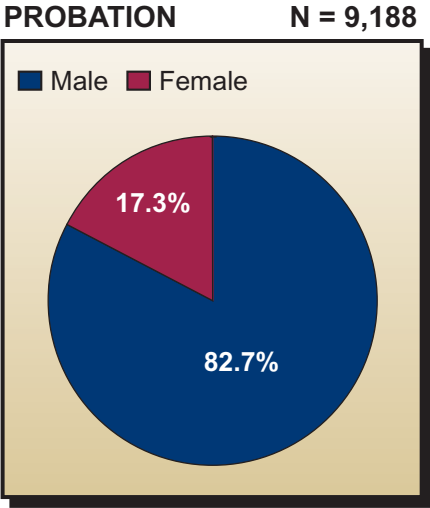
DETENTION ADMISSIONS

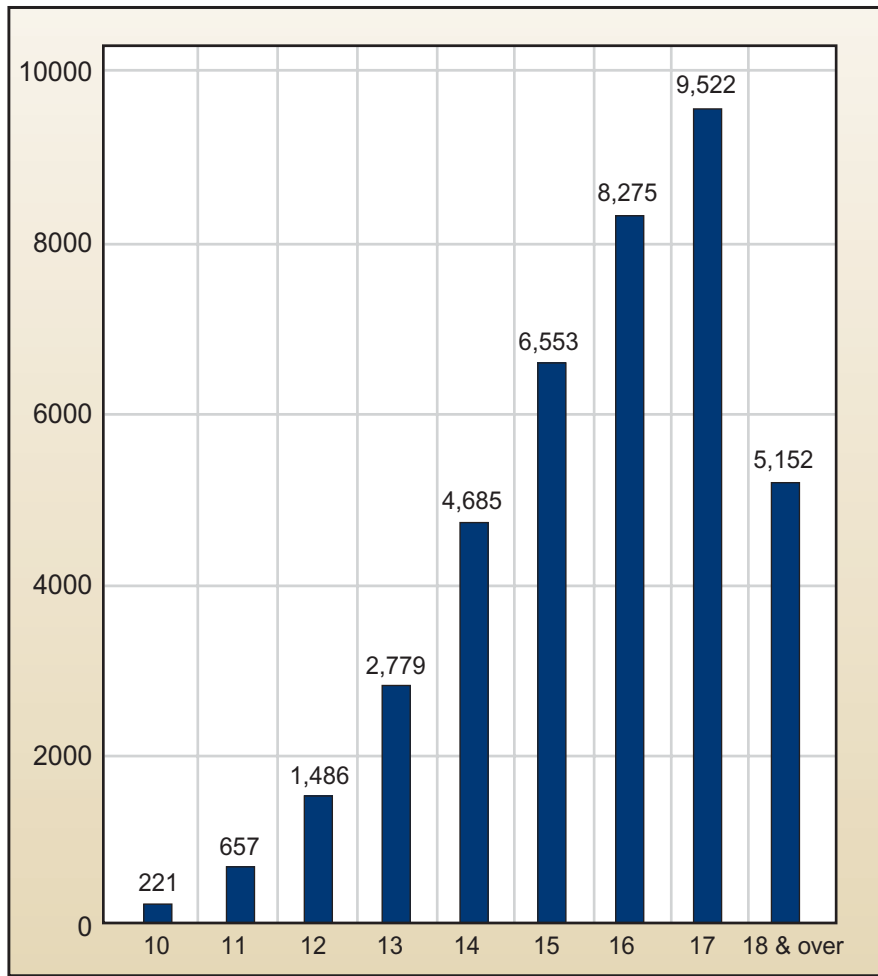
Juvenile court dispositions in Pennsylvania's juvenile justice system primarily involve males. In 2002, males accounted for 78.4 percent of all juvenile court dispositions, 82.7 percent of probation dispositions, 88.2 percent of dispositions involving placement and 95.9 percent of transfers to criminal court.



Total Dispositions by Age, 2002

Seventeen year olds accounted for 9,522 (24.2%) of the 39,333 juvenile delinquency dispositions in 2002, representing the most dispositions for any age group. Juveniles who were age 16 accounted for 8,275 (21.0%), and juveniles who were age 15 accounted for 6,553 (16.7%) of the dispositions in 2002.

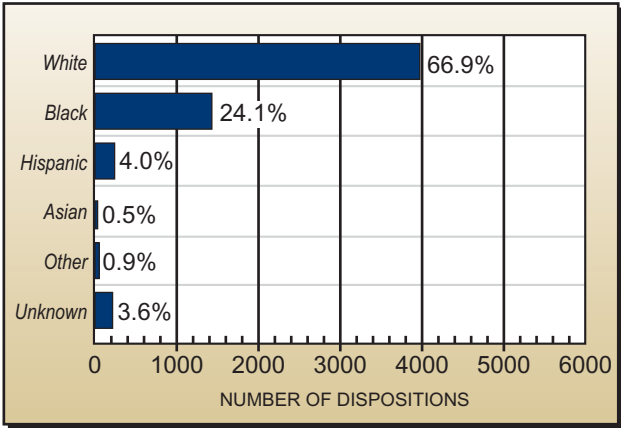

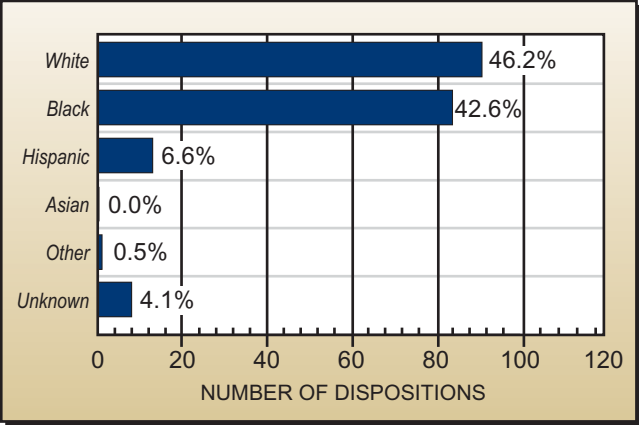

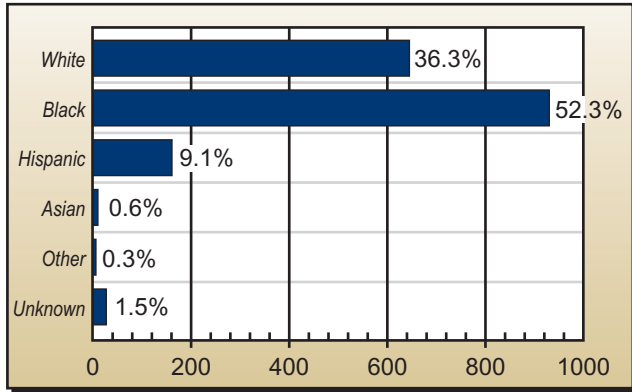

Race and Ethnicity of Juveniles in Selected Placements, 2002

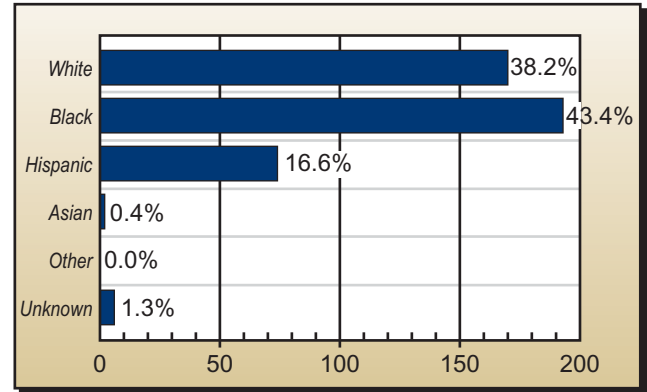

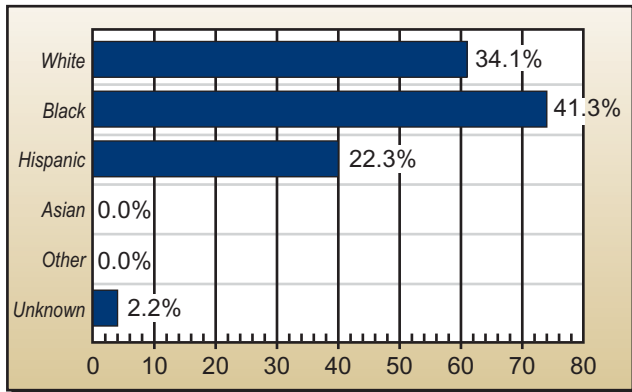

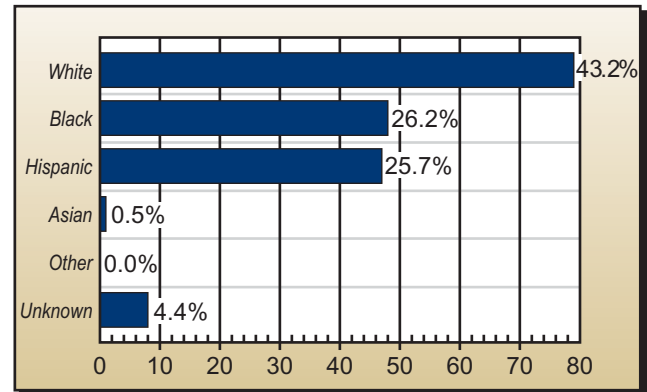

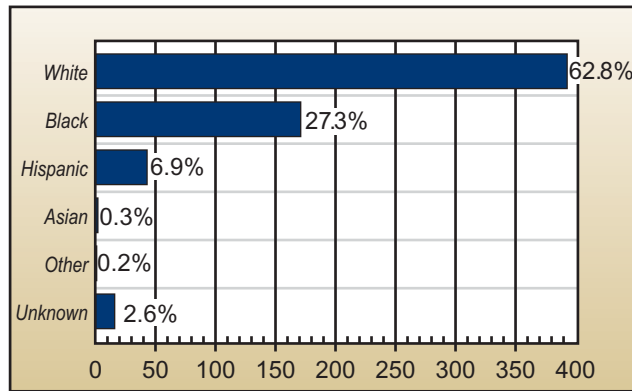

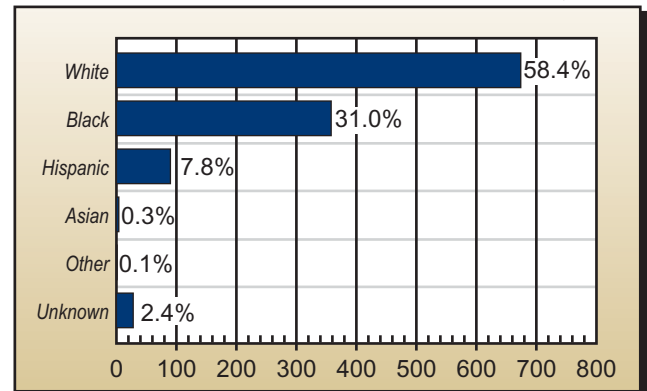

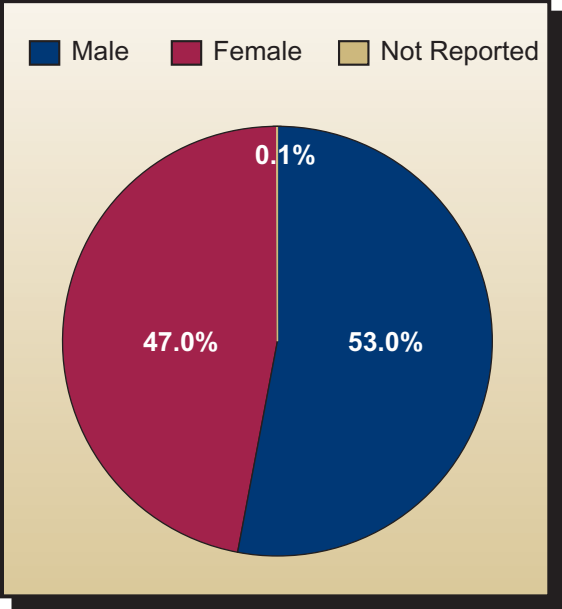

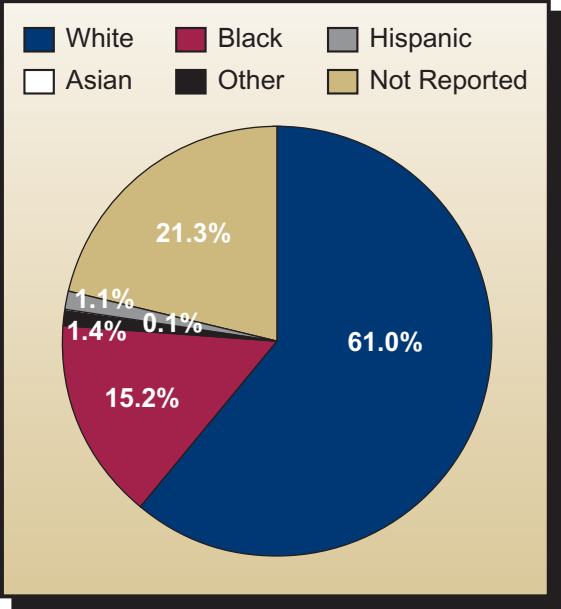

GENDER N = 1,971

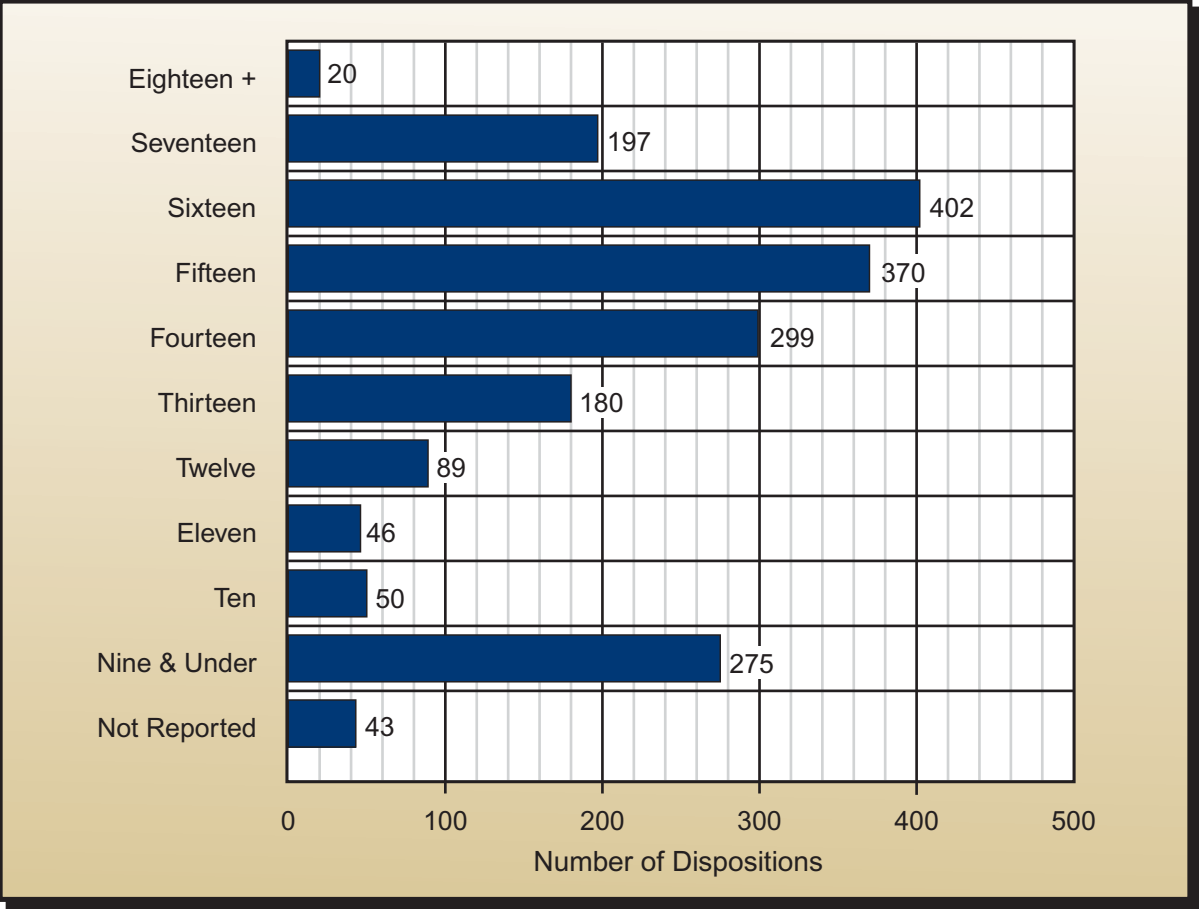


RACE AND ETHNICITY N = 1,971
